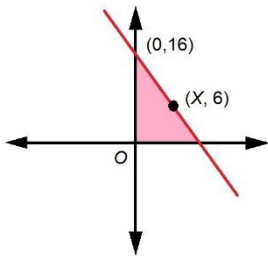


Figure NOT drawn to scale. On the coordinate axes shown above, the shaded triangle has the following area: 48
